Terms & Conditions for Remote Bidding Services



Please find below the Terms & Conditions for using our Remote Bidding Services for telephone, proxy or internet bidding.

In order for your bid to be considered, you will need to complete and sign the Remote Bidding Form overleaf, ticking the service you wish to use, and ensure that the form, along with the required deposit and identification documentation, arrives to us via e-mail at least 48 hours prior to the auction date. TELEPHONE bids will be limited therefore completing the form will not automatically guarantee you a slot. You will be notified of this as soon as we receive your form, or via a customised e-mail if you have registered your interest against a particular property.

Please note that you will need to complete a separate form for each lot you wish to bid on.

For PROXY bidding you must state the maximum proxy bid price to which the Auctioneer is authorised to bid on your behalf and this amount must be to an exact figure. For example, the wording such as "£100 over the highest bid in the room" will not be accepted.

For TELEPHONE and INTERNET bidding, the "bid price" can be left blank.

The required deposit to register to bid is £2,000 plus the buyer's fee of £600 inclusive of VAT. This is to be paid by bank transfer to our corporate client account, details of which will be provided to you once the correct documentation has been received.

In compliance with Money Laundering Regulations all buyers are required to provide a certified copy of a passport or photocard driving licence and a copy of a recent utility bill or financial statement (issued within the last 3 months). These must accompany the signed Remote Bidding Form for your bid to be accepted.
