The site was previously granted planning under reference 17/00509/FUL for change of use from a public house to 12 flats and 2 \times semi-detached houses with associated parking. However a more recent application under reference 21/00796/OUT has been submitted for a scheme of 24 flats on the site. The site area is approximately 2225 sm (0.549 acres) in size and offers excellent development potential.
